

VA Portland Health Care System is seeking a Physician-Scientist Staff Psychiatrist



VA Portland Health Care System (VAPORHCS) is recruiting a staff psychiatrist with prior training and success as a physician-scientist, specifically with expertise in clinical or health services research, and who is able to successfully compete for peer-reviewed research support on topics especially relevant to Veterans including depression, suicide prevention, post-traumatic stress disorder, bipolar disorder, chronic pain, substance use disorder, or schizophrenia. Research space and equipment will be provided. Start up support (protected time and research support) will be negotiated. VAPORHCS is closely affiliated with Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) and the position includes an academic appointment at OHSU.

VAPORHCS is a large tertiary care (1A) facility affiliated with Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU). VAPORHCS currently has over 100 investigators and more than 500 active protocols. In fiscal year 2018, VAPORHCS scientists were successful in competing for over \$32 million in research grants from the VA, NIH, DOD and other sources. VAPORHCS ranks 7th among all VAs nationwide in total research funding. OHSU and the VAPORHCS are linked by a pedestrian sky bridge that facilitates our close partnership. Our setting in the beautiful Pacific Northwest further enhances this opportunity.
