Ondria C. Gleason, MD is Professor and Chair of the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Oklahoma School of Community Medicine. She completed her residency in Psychiatry at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in Iowa City and is board certified in Psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology with subspecialty certification in Psychosomatic Medicine. She has received additional training in academic medicine administration through her participation in the Program for Chiefs of Clinical Services at Harvard School of Public Health in Boston. Dr. Gleason's clinical and academic interests lie at the intersection of medicine and psychiatry with particular interest in psychiatric presentations of medical illness, substance induced psychiatric illness, delirium, and co-morbid psychiatric and medical disorders. She is a Fellow of both the American Psychiatric Association and the Academy of Consultation Liaison Psychiatry. She currently serves as the Vice President of the Tulsa County Medical Society. She previously served as Interim Dean of the University of Oklahoma School of Community Medicine from 2013 – 2015, as well as President of the Oklahoma Psychiatric Association, and as President of the AACDP.
